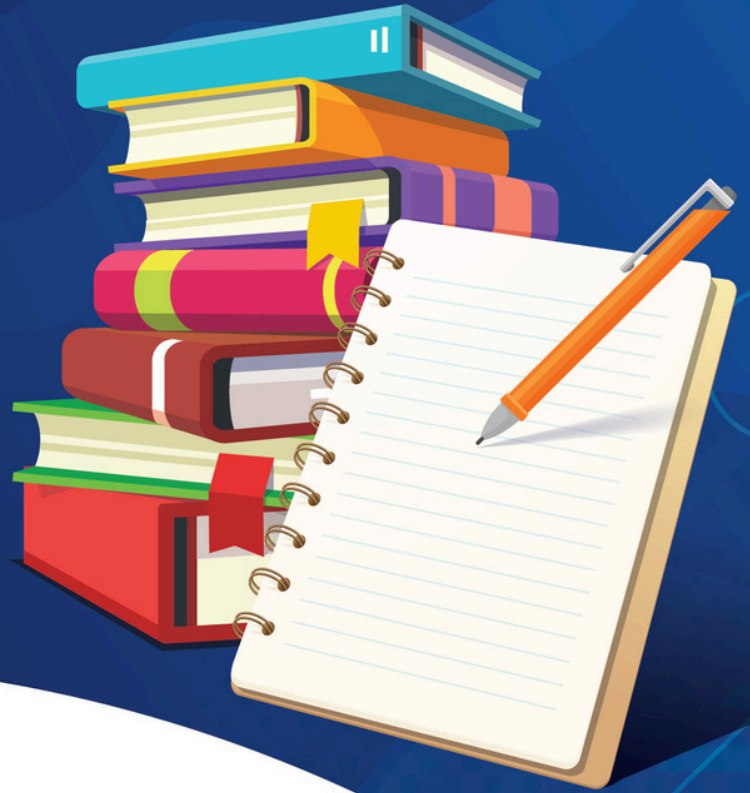


Troncoso Reading Prizes Contest



September 15 to December 8

AT THE **SERGIO TRONCOSO LIBRARY**

Students are challenged to read a minimum of 5 books between September 15 and December 8, and write an essay (must be 100 words or less) about one of the books read during the timeframe.

The students who read the most books will be eligible to win a prize. EPPL librarians will judge the essays to determine the winners of each category. Previous winners will not be considered for future prizes unless a student who won the 5th-8th grade category is now eligible for a prize in the 9th-12th grade category.
